

Top three search strategies

This **infographic** shows you how "quotation marks" and wild card (?) and truncation (*) symbols can make a big difference in the results you retrieve.



Wildcard: Use a question mark (?), hashtag (#) or a pound (£) symbol to replace each unknown character and variant spelling.

Wom?n will search for information containing the words 'woman' or 'women'; hum#r will search for information containing the words 'humor' or 'humour'. Plurals and possessives of the searched term are not listed in the results. E.g., for colo#r, the terms "colors" and "colours" will not appear in the search results.

Truncation: The asterisk (*), question mark (?) and dollar sign (\$) symbols are used in databases in which a symbol is placed after a word or a truncated word. Placing the truncation symbol too soon in a word should be avoided.

If the truncation symbol is *, then the truncated word, laugh*, will search for results containing laugh, laughter, laughing etc.

For example: hum* will search for results containing humour, but it will also retrieve unrelated terms like human, humbug, humerus, hummus, etc.

Stop words

Stop words are frequently occurring, insignificant words that appear in a database record, article or web page.

Common stop words include a, an, the, in, of, on, are, be, if, into, and which.

Some databases use quotes around stop words. Example: **Title keyword**= out "of" India retrieves **title**: Out of India

Search tips for Google Scholar

Searching on Google Scholar is similar to using Google search, with many of the same search options available.

Google Scholar automatically places AND between words:

Urban stress health

Place quotation marks around phrases or titles to find verbatim results:

"public policy"

"On the Origin of Species"

Search for alternate terms using OR, with the terms enclosed in parentheses:

("first grade" OR "second grade") (theory OR model)

You can also use the advanced Google Scholar search to create your search string. Creating a complex Google Scholar search can be difficult.

A good Google Scholar strategy is to try multiple searches, adjusting your keywords with each search.

Manupatra is a comprehensive online legal and business policy database.
