Keyword Search Tips

Try changing to Advanced Search.

Adjacency

Multiple words are not searched together as a phrase. They will be found in various parts of the record. To search for a phrase, enclose your search terms in quotation marks.

(example: "AbdouMaliq Simone")

Truncation

Words may be right-hand truncated using an asterisk. Use a single asterisk * to truncate any number of characters.

(example: environment* agency)

Anchored Searching

You may use ^ and \$ to indicate "phrase begins with" and "phrase ends with," respectively, within a search phrase enclosed in quotation marks.

(examples: "^harry" for phrases that begin with the term *harry*. "stone\$" for phrases that end in *stone*.)

Databases

<u>Lens.org</u> ingests, cleans, aggregates, normalises and serves over 225+ million scholarly works, 127+ million global patent records, and more than 370+ million patent sequences drawn from diverse data sources.

IndiaStat.com is a socio-economic and statistical database with a cluster of 57 sites including India-specific, sector specific, region-specific and state-specific sites providing authentic and comprehensive compilation of secondary level socio-economic statistical data about India and its states, regions and sectors on more than 35 variables.

<u>Smart Cities India</u>: <u>Open Data Platform</u> hosts data from the 100 smart cities of India, categorised by cities and sectors.

<u>Smartnet Library at NIUA</u> gives access to key resources in the urban sector focused on India.

<u>International Household Survey Network</u> provides datasets on a variety of socio-economic indicators.



India Urban Data Exchange is a data exchange platform for India cities.

<u>Google Earth</u> is a platform that allows users to explore the globe while customising their experience with various features.

<u>ADB Data Library</u> offers datasets and data stories on various themes and countries.

World Bank Open Data provides data on global development.

<u>Data.gov.in</u> is an Open Government Data (OGD) platform that supports the Open Data initiative of Government of India.

<u>Google Dataset</u> provides data on a wide range of themes and formats sourced from repositories worldwide.

<u>Datahub</u> (India) has more than 100 India specific datasets.

<u>Census of India, 2011</u> provides information on houses, household amenities and assets, as well as primary census abstracts for states and union territories. Related resources: <u>Census of India, 2001</u> and <u>Census of India, 1991</u>.

<u>Development Data Library (DDS) provides machine-readable data funded</u> <u>by USAID.</u> It is organised into various subcategories, including Democracy, Human Rights and Governance; Economic Growth; Education and Social Services; Health; Humanitarian Assistance; Peace and Security; Program Development and Oversight.

<u>Inter-university Consortium for Political and Social Research</u> (ICPSR) data archives hosts data on social and behavioural sciences.

<u>USGS Earth Explorer</u> is an open-source satellite remote sensing data portal which comprises datasets from various satellites programmes.

Global Human Settlement Layer project portal supported by the European Commission and GEO Human Planet Initiative, provides various global spatial datasets related to human settlements, like gridded population, built-up presence, settlement typology and urban growth. These datasets are available for multiple time frames and spatial resolution.

<u>Socioeconomic data and applications center (SEDAC)</u> is one of NASA's data archives housing spatial and tabular datasets covering various socioeconomic parameters.

<u>WorldPop</u> is an open spatial demographic data and research portal providing datasets related to human population distribution at high resolution.

<u>Landscan</u> by Oak Ridge National Laboratory provides a gridded global population distribution at approximately 1 km spatial resolution annually.

MIT Senseable City Lab is a research initiative at MIT focussed on gaining an integrated understanding of cities from various perspectives such as design, urban planning, engineering, physics, biology, social science and data analytics and visualisation. This portal houses research, publication projects, and resources for studying and visualising these aspects.



Open Source GIS Tools

QGIS is used to create, edit, visualise, analyse and publish geospatial information for spatial data processing, visualisation and analysis.

Google Earth Pro helps create maps with advanced tools for visualisation of satellite data.

Google My Maps is an online open-source tool used for drawing, searching, importing and personalising custom maps. It serves as a platform for creating GIS data and mapping places.

Open Street Maps provides crowdsourced maps that contribute to and maintain data about roads, trails, cafés, railway stations and more.

<u>Bhuvan</u> is a free GIS application used to visualise data and maps for sectors, services and governance systems.

<u>India Place Finder (GIS data)</u> is a tool to find geographic information from any alphabetical toponym in India for census towns and villages.

State GIS Portal offers GIS data at the state and union territories level.
