May 2026

This month's New Collection features several additions from the Penguin Classics series, including *The Tinderbox* by Hans Christian Andersen, *Trimalchio's Feast* by Petronius, and *Olalla* by Robert Louis Stevenson. The collection also highlights important works engaging with Dalit history, caste, and social justice, including Anand Teltumbde's *Iconoclast: A Reflective Biography of Dr Babasaheb Ambedkar* and Y. B. Satyanarayana's *My Father Baliah*. Among the notable titles on history and politics are Anirudh Kanisetti's *Lords of Earth and Sea: A History of the Chola Empire*, Rosinka Chaudhuri's *India's First Radicals: Young Bengal and the British Empire* and Mohammed Al-Zaqzoq and Mahmoud Alshaer's *Letters from Gaza: By the People, from the Year That Has Been*. The collection further includes works on architecture, ecology, psychology and self-development, alongside a rich selection of fiction, short stories, and memoirs from India and across the world.
